Due to Tucson Fire Marshall Requirements, all motorized display vehicles must adhere to Fire Code Rules and Regulations and must come with no more than ¼ tank of fuel, must unhook battery terminals once inside, and must tape over gas cap. Tucson Fire Department requires a fire extinguisher to be kept with each vehicle.

All vehicles will be on display for the entire two day event and vehicle owners should plan on setting up either on Friday, September 3rd (10am-5pm) or Saturday, September 4th (7am – 9am) while not removing their vehicle until Sunday, September 5th after 5pm. Overnight security will be provided.

Club members desiring to park together should plan to arrive together. Parking is first-come, first-served basis. Car trailer parking available in close proximity to show area. NO PETS, STEREOS, TENTS, FIREARMS, DRUGS, MOTORIZED SCOOTERS PERMITTED!
